- Please include a brief presentation title, and the full names of all authors and presenters
- Case studies and formal white papers are encouraged, but not required
- Include field data where possible to support conclusions
- Joint presentations between operators and service companies are encouraged
- Presentations that are commercial in nature will not be accepted



Format

Please follow the following format when writing your abstract:

1. OBJECTIVES/SCOPE: List the objective(s) and scope of the proposed presentation
2. METHODS PROCEDURES, PROCESS: Briefly explain overall approach, methods, procedures and process
3. RESULTS, OBSERVATIONS, CONCLUSIONS: Describe results, observations and conclusions
